Dear Sir/Madam,

We hereby would like to inform you that the Government of Curaçao has decided, as per Ministerial Regulation P.B. 2022 No. 38, dated 3 May 2022 to amend the restrictions for entry into Curaçao. These restrictions are effective 6 May 2022, until further notice. This directive supersedes the previously issued directive CURCW/22/087-2 dated 8 March 2022.

**Air Travel to Curaçao from all countries is allowed under the following conditions.**

A. All Passengers travelling to Curaçao are allowed entry under the following conditions:

- A Public Health Passenger Locator Card (PLC) and an Immigration ED, Embarkation – Disembarkation Card need to be completed online at: <https://dicardcuracao.com/portal>, **no earlier than 48 hours before the flight**. The passenger shall have a digital or printed copy of the completed PLC form and the Immigration ED Card available for Immigration upon arrival in Curaçao, as received per email from the portal.

**Exempted from completing the PLC Form:**

- a. Active flight crew members.

**Exempted from completing the Immigration ED Card are:**

- a. Residents of Curaçao;
- b. Active flight crew members.

- To be allowed to board the flight, the passenger must show the completed PLC Form and ED Card in hard copy or in electronic format.

- 1) **Passengers departing Curaçao** shall comply with the entry requirements of their destination and adhere to the requirements of the Airport Authority.
- 2) The aircraft shall be handled according to standard operating procedures to ensure and continue safe and normal operations.
- 3) **Active Flight crew members** shall be allowed to continue their duties while complying with the sanitary rules applied by the Government of Curaçao.

- 4) **Transit/Transfer** passengers who continue their flight within twenty-four (24) hours of arrival are **exempted** from completing the PLC Form. They should comply with all entry requirements of their destination.
- 5) Passengers who arrive in Curaçao or during their stay on the island shall adhere to the local medical protocols to include hygiene requirements.
- 6) Passengers who arrive in Curaçao or during their stay on the island who have been determined to be infected with the COVID-19 virus are obliged to immediately go into a **ten (10) day** mandatory quarantine or isolation, including taking a PCR test.
- 7) Specific conditions and requirements may apply as determined by or on behalf the Ministry of Health of the Government of Curaçao to include but not limited to Quarantine requirements & Monitoring and a COVID-19 test at the cost of the person/traveler.
- 8) The Immigration Authority and the Department of Health of the Government of Curaçao will be performing their required screening and questioning of arriving passengers.

This remains a fluid situation and updates to this directive will be published as often as deemed necessary.
